ENTRIES:

The application for participation in the race can be submitted by an individual person, club or the team captain who represents the specific athlete. The application must be submitted electronically by means of registration in the Latvian Ski Association website www.infoski.lv or by an electronic mail to info@infoski.lv. The registration must take place no later than 5 days before the race. (According to Baltic Cup 2012 alpine ski competition rules).

ACCOMODATION:

All teams, team officials and guests can book their accommodation using website www.suomu.com at „Hotelli Suomutunturi” which is located by the slope. Special price for accommodation for Baltic Cup competitors and friends is 600,- eur per cottage (8 beds) per week or 100,- eur per cottage per day. Hotel accommodation with bed & breakfast is 45,- eur per person per night. Contact phone no. +358 403770175.

CATERING:

Teams are also welcome to use restaurant „Hotelli Suomutunturi”, price for lunch buffet will be 10,- eur and for dinner buffet - 12,- eur.

LIFT TICKETS:

For the participating teams and guests the price for the lift ticket per person per day will be 20,- eur.

RACE OFFICE AND TEAM CAPTAINS MEETINGS:

Race Office will be located at „Hotelli Suomutunturi” and will open one hour before each team captains meeting. The first team captains meeting will be held on Sunday, 11th of March, 20.00 local time.

RULES:

Rules for the Baltic Cup 2012 competition will be attached by this document and published at the website www.infoski.lv.

INSURANCE:

Competitors compete on their own liability. The national ski associations and the team officials are responsible for adequate insurance for all their competitors.

PARTICIPATION PAYMENT:

Team leaders will be charged 15,- eur for each racer each discipline. The payment will be charged at the end of each team captains meeting before receiving the bib numbers. There will be no charge for the SG training.

PROVISIONAL PROGRAMME*:

SAT 10TH official day of arrival
SUN 11TH individual training day and the first team captains meeting
MON 12TH training SG
TUE 13TH SG race Baltic Cup**
WED 14TH GS race Baltic Cup**
THU 15TH SL race Baltic Cup**
FRI 16TH race for children group D (eventually reserve day)
SAT 17TH day of departure

* Baltic Cup 2012 is not a FIS race. FIS points will not be calculated!

** It is expected to organize youth races (groups C,B,A) in the morning, and follow with the adult races (groups jun, elite, senior) later in the afternoon.

AWARDING

Age groups A, B, C

- The first three owners of the best results from EST, LAT, LTU are awarded with Baltic Cup trophies.
- The best result owners of the 4th, 5th and 6th places from EST, LAT, LTU are awarded with diplomas.
- If other nations are ranked in top-6 they are awarded with diplomas and prizes.

Age groups Jun, Elite, Senior are awarded according to Baltic Cup 2012 rules.
