ENTRIES

The application for participation can be submitted by an individual person, club or the team captain who represents the specific Ski Association and the athlete.

The application must be submitted through on-line registration form www.ski.lv. The registration must take place no later than 48 hours before the start of the race according to Baltic Cup 2021-2022 Alpine ski competition rules, published in www.ski.lv and www.snowarena.lt. The online registration system will be closed **17.11. @ 9.00. am**

For the FIS races all entries must be sent according to the ICR. All entries must be sent so that the Organizing Committee receives them before the final date of entry (**14.11. @ 20.00**). The organizers must have a final and complete list not later than 24 hours before the first draw.

Every entry should include:

- Name, first name, year of birth, National Ski Association;
- An exact definition of the event, discipline and age group for which the entry is made.
- Contact information of the team leader or the individual athlete.

RACE OFFICE AND TEAM CAPTAIN'S MEETING

Race Office will be located the same place where the races will be held at „Snow Arena”, and will work daily from Monday, 15th November from 17:00. Race office closes one hour before each team captains meeting. All team captain's meetings will be held online. The first team captains meeting will be held on Tuesday, 15th November at 20:00. After the entry deadline the teams will be asked to confirm their athletes with a payment of entry fee and the contacts of **ONE** team captain per team to receive the link for the online team captains meeting by email.

IMPORTANT: When sending the entries, nominate **ONE** team official indicating telephone number and email address that will be responsible for all team entries for your team.

ENTRY FEES

Entry fee of EUR 20.00 per racer per discipline will be charged. Entry fees must be paid by cash at the race office during operating hours 16.00-19.00 or at least one hour before the draw.

Entry fee for the FIS racers that are not from the organizing nation within their FIS quota only will include a free lift access.

Lift tickets price per racer per race day will be 15.00 EUR, or according to the price list of Snow Arena for teams.

RULES

Rules for the Baltic Cup 2021/2022 competition will be published at the website www.ski.lv and www.snowarena.lt.

INSURANCE

Competitors compete on their own liability. National Ski Associations and team officials are responsible for adequate insurance for all their competitors. (ICR: art., 212.4).

COVID 19

Every entered team or individual is responsible to be aware about the covid measures and regulations entering Lithuania from their home country or address of residence. Additional restrictions might be in place during the event in SnowArena, and it is the responsibility of all teams and individuals to follow them. The information about last changes of the existing restrictions will be communicated through the official channels of the organizer by email to the entered teams before the event. Or during the event by the official WhatsApp group.
