### ENTRIES

The application for participation can be submitted by an individual person, club or the team captain who represents a specific Ski Association and the athlete.

The application for Baltic Cup races must be submitted through online registration form [www.ski.lv](http://www.ski.lv) or by electronic mail to [info@tartuslalom.ee](mailto:info@tartuslalom.ee). The registration must take place no later than 48 hours before the start of the race according to Baltic Cup 2019-2020 alpine ski competition rules, published in [www.ski.lv](http://www.ski.lv) and [www.suusaliit.ee](http://www.suusaliit.ee)

For the FIS races all entries must be sent according to the ICR to Estonian Ski Associations Secretary General Katrin Mesila via email [katrin@suusaliit.ee](mailto:katrin@suusaliit.ee) . All entries must be sent so that the Organizing Committee receives them before the final date of entry. The organizers must have a final and complete list not later than 24 hours before the first draw.

Every entry must include:

- Name, first name, year of birth, National Ski Association/ski club;
- An exact definition of the event, discipline and age group for which the entry is made.
- Contact information of the team leader or the individual athlete.
- Lift pass information.

## RACE OFFICE AND TEAM CAPTAIN'S MEETING

Race Office will be located in the main building (cafe house under the front slope) of Munakas ski resort. The first team captain's meeting for the FIS Entry League race will be held on **Saturday, 11th of January, 7.30** in the race office.

Bibs and lift tickets for U12, U14, U16 and M will be handed out in the race office from **7.30 to 14.00**. **All teams must confirm their entry list by 14.00**.

## ENTRY FEES

Entry fee of EUR 20.00 per racer discipline will be charged.

Entry fee for the FIS racers that are not from the organizing nation within their FIS quota only will include a free lift access.

Team captains will be asked to confirm their entries and the entry fee must be paid to the organizing committee via bank transfer at least 24 hours before the first TCM. Paying at the venue in the race office will not be possible - it must be done beforehand.

**Entry fees and lift passes need to be paid together.** This means that the payment per day per racer will be EUR 20.00 entry fee + 11.00 lift pass. Passes will be handed out at the race office together with bibs. **Race office open from 7.30 to 14.00.**

## LIFT PASSES

For race days, 11th and 12th of January, we have provided a special lift pass price for racers which is EUR 11.00 per athlete per day (normal price EUR 29.00). **This price is for racers only and lift passes need to be paid together with the entry fees via bank transfer as mentioned before.**

## ACCOMMODATION

Organizers have provided accommodation in Kääriku Sports Center located 15 min drive from the race venue. Ski waxing facilities provided in the hotel. <http://www.kaariku.com/en> Depending on the room type, price per person will be around EUR 15.00-25.00 per night. All room prices include breakfast and are available for booking for the following dates 10-12.01.2020.

Since the organizers have pre booked all the rooms for teams, **you will need to mention a code word "Baltic Cup" in order to book a room.** All payments and arrangements with accommodation will be handled by Kääriku Sports Center.

**The reservations can be made until 2nd of December 2019, after that the organizers do not guarantee availability for 10-12.01.2020.**
