



FIS TD: Necati Kaplan

10.07.2015 Mass Start F

• Preparation of course was good. Actually we had a critical down hill and sharp dangerous curve but OC made very good safety preparation with 2 times alpine C net. Asphalt have good condition there was some broken part but OC fixed it properly. Transportation in the morning is ok, start finish are ok. There was equipment control before the start and no any problem with equipment. We had only some problem with sound system which was not working as it should be. Flower ceremony and winner ceremony are ok.

11.07.2015 Sprint F

Sprint race was organized in city centre as it has been organizing many years. It was successful organization
with our any problem. There was photo finish system. Sound system was perfect at the start line and finish line
together with good speaker. Flower ceremony and winner ceremony is ok.

12.07.2015 Uphill C

- Course was ok, there was enough number of controller, there was no any problem. Flower ceremony and winner ceremony are ok. It could be better to set some big umbrella for the teams during the winner ceremony against the hot sunny weather condition.
- We had a little problem with the calculation of overall ranking I realised some mistakes with the calculation but it was corrected letter on. It was the first time FIS points in ROL WC and FIS Points calculated with out any problem.
- Generally accommodation, transportation, team captain meetings, competitions, time keeping, opening ceremony jury cooperation are ok.



FIS ROL WC 2nd stage: Madona (LAT)

FIS TD: Erik Björelind (SWE)Sprint: Very nice track "downtown", with four separate racks, 250 m slightly uphill. Starting with start gate in qualification and start line with double poling first 5 meters in finals. Some TC was a little confused before but many said to me after that this was very good procedures, but with double poling also in the qualification.

Prologue, C: From OC supplied rollerskis. Little bit confusing for teams and athletes. Skid was tested 1 hour the day before race, plus 30 minutes just before start. Some teams was sanctioned for non approved technical adjustments on the skis. More information of the rules is needed. Very nice rollerski track, more than 4 meters wide, but two downhill sections with sharps curves. For safety reasons OC put up B-nets and madrassas. Two athletes went off the track during training but no one during competition. No injuries

Pursuit F: Same track as prologue, also supplied rollerskis. Track is little to short so we had some overlapping to take care of.

General: An ambitious OC, but they where to few, to workload was too heavy on too few. Experience and knowledge of this kind of events could be improved, and will so be over time. Timekeeping very good including reporting. Not so much audience. Skills in English of OC varied

COUNTRYFIS ROL WC 3rd stage: Trento 19-20 September 2015

- FIS TD: Marco Mapelli
- OC : ASD Charlie Gaule
- Before race : Excellent relation with OC and other Jury's member
- Very good the choice of road : sprint in real downtown , Individual distance competition to M.te Bondone very nice . Asphalt in very good condition.
- **Problem during race** : Timekeeping created some problem before the sprint qualification. For this problem the start was postponed 10 minutes. Also some little problem about the starting list for individual : the data processing had to manage manually the starting order according to overall WC and some problem arrived.
- **Structure** : both in Trento and in Bondone the OC provide excellent facilities for athletes ; in Trento a gym was reserved for changing , showers accessing directly by warming-up close track , in Bondone all the hotel Montana (excellent hotel) was reserved for athletes and teams. In both days the OC granted a very good lunch and dinner at goog prince (10€).



FIS ROL WSC: Val di Fiemme 23-27 September, 2015

FIS TD: Guy Magand (FRA); FIS Ass. TD: Georg Zipfel (GER)

Individual up-hill C:

- Course checked and used at 98% last year
- Problem for entries (Russian Team) / Races perfect for athletes, spectators and technical staff but very bad for the Time Keeping Company

Individual Sprint (200 meters) :

- High sport level / few early starts in the heats.
- Rumanian TC did not respect of safety rules (eye glasses for protection)
- Extra artificial lighting were added for the competitions finals.

Team Sprint

- Tough competitions without any problem (sports or time keeping company)
- 1 early start for the RUS senior men team (due to the fall of Nikita KRYUKOV).

MASS START F

- Jury meeting during the TCM in order to solve the question of 80 meters of cobbles (paved section).
- Two starts like cycling races. Top CC athletes in start list: Dementiev / Pellegrino / Nockler / Sundin....
- No broken poles for WCH (senior men) and only 3 on promotional race.

General coments

- Opening, price giving and closing ceremonies were perfect : high level standard as usual in Val di Fiemme...
- Hard work for Jury Members due weak time keeping company and lack of proper time keeping equipment.
- Good event for athletes and spectators, good for promotion FIS SUMMER CC SKI !!!



General comments on Jury work in FIS ROL WC 2016

- Early TD inspection is very important for successful WC event
- FIS TD must report to Chairman of FIS s.c. ROL if there are relevant problems
- Event schedule (time for TC meetings, official trainings, competition programme, competition course info etc.) must <u>be fixed</u> in details in <u>Invitation</u> and should not be changed (without relevant reason) once it is published. But if any change is done it <u>must be noticed</u> in all relevant info sources: FIS calendar, WC stage or NSA website etc.
- Jury decisions & sanctions must be proportional in cases where rules infraction are not affecting final results or not endangers safety.
- If many problems appear: rank & solve according to their relevance
- Jury must work & communicates as 1 unite team.

II. FIS ICR proposals



396.2.8. Rollerski equipment change

396.2.8 Competitors are permitted to change or repair equipment during the competition but they must do this without any outside assistance other than being handed the replacement equipment or tools. Rollerski change must be done according to article 343.12.2 And new article:

396.2.11 If Competition Organizer provides official rollerski equipment, rollerski change during the competition may be done only in official service point (boxes) according to articles 343.12.2-343.12.3

396.2.12. If Competition Organizer provides official rollerski equipment, rollerski repair during Official training or before competition may be done only in Official service point provided by OC.



Proposals for FIS ROL WC WSC rules



- Procedures/sanctions for <u>WC cancellation</u>
- Clarification for <u>WC ranking points (double</u> points)
- New articles for <u>Mass start Bonus</u>
 <u>seconds/Stage events</u>
- Gradual <u>increase in WC prize money</u>, clarifications for prize money distribution.

WC cancellation procedures

• 1.2.6 Substitution, Cancellation

- If for any reason a FIS ROL WC or FIS ROL WSC competition cannot take place, the FIS Nordic Office and Chairman of FIS Sub-committee for Roller Skiing must be informed immediately.
- Depending on the case, the competitions can be transferred to an alternate location, cancelled or postponed to a later date in the season.
- 1.2.6.1 Alternate Location
- In principle, a transferred competition shall be carried out in the same country. The National Ski Association is responsible to coordinate and ensure the transfer of knowledge, information and finances to the new OC.
- If that is not possible, the competition may be carried out in another country.
- 1.2.6.2. Cancellation
- If the decision is taken later than 14 days before the event, the original OC must pay the travel costs to the teams entered at the date of the decision and be in charge for cancellation fees of the accommodation.

Mass start bonus seconds

• 5.2.2 Bonus World Cup points in Mass Start races

- Use of <u>Bonus World Cup points in given Mass Start races will be decided before the WC season together with OC and FIS s.c.</u> for Roller Skiing.
- If Bonus World Cup points in given Mass Start races will be used it will be published in FIS ROL WC calendar in beginning of WC season.
- The first 10 athletes will get the following World Cup points at the defined bonus positions as mentioned below:

•	1 st place =	15 points	6 th place	=	5 points	
•	2 nd place	=	12 points	7 th place	=	4 points
•	3 rd place 4 th place	=	10 points	8 th place	=	3 points
	4 th place	=	8 points	9 th place	=	2 points
•	5 th place	=	6 points	10 th place	=	1 point

- In order for these World Cup points to be awarded, the competitor must complete the competition (reach the finish line).
- If an athlete is ranked in the top 10 in an intermediate sprint and does not finish the competition, the positions and bonus points in the intermediate sprints remain the same for the other athletes. There is no reallocation of the points that were earned by the athlete who did not finish. This does not apply in the case of disqualification.
- In all Mass Start races the additional bonus positions are implemented like:
- Race length Number of bonus positions

- until 10 km 1
- 11 20 km 2
- 30 km 4
- 50 km



- 5.2.1.3 For the ROL WC Final stage double points will be given (i.e. first: 200, second 160, ...)
- 5.2.1.4 During the ROL WSC years, all the competitions within the ROL WSC program will be counted for the ROL WC Overall Standings.

p.s. No more 2 x points for WC Final stage

CROSS FIS ROL WC stage event rules

- 5.3. FIS Rollerski World Cup Stage events
- 5.3.1. Basic rules
- - Only entry for the all stages is possible.
- Abandonment in one race will lead to exclusion from the rest of the stage event.
- The overall results for the FIS ROL WC will be based on the overall time score in the all stages (including sprint).
- There will be bonus seconds for the top 30 in the Sprint race. The bonus seconds listed below are subtracted from the competitor's actual race time before being added into the overall time score.
- 1st place = 30 seconds
- 2nd place = 27 seconds
- 3rd place = 24 seconds
- 4th place = 23 seconds
- 5th place = 22 seconds
- 6th place = 21 seconds
- 7th place = 16 seconds
- 8th place = 15 seconds
- 9th place = 14 seconds
- 10th place = 13 seconds
- 11th place = 12 seconds
- 12st place = 11 seconds
- 13th place to 15th place = 5 seconds
- 16th place to 20th place = 4 seconds
- 21st place to 25th place = 3 seconds
- 26th place to 30th place = 2 seconds

FIS ROL WC stage event rules

• 5.3.1.2. FIS ROL WC points for the FIS ROL WC stage event

• FIS ROL WC stage event points will be awarded after the last Stage according to the final FIS ROL WC stage standings. The factor will be 2, i.e. the winner will receive 200 points:

In addition to the Overall World Cup points awarded, each stage will also receive the following World Cup points. The daily World Cup points will count for the
overall and the discipline World Cup standings. On the last day, the winner of the day (fastest time on this stage for those specific kilometres) will get the World Cup
points and Daily Prize-Money.

- 7.1.1 Minimum prize money for FIS ROL WC stage is EUR 4500,00
- 7.1.2 No prize money is provided for ROL WSC.
- 7.1.3 Prize money is equally split <u>between</u> Senior Men (EUR 2250,00) and Senior Ladies (EUR 2250,00) categories and proportionally divided according to number of disciplines per WC event
- 7.1.4 The local organizer can increase the prize money but cannot decrease. The local organizer can provide prize money or valuable material prizes also for Junior categories.
