

“JIBB JABB GAMES” FREESKI AND SNOWBOARDING COMPETITION RULES

1. TIME, PLACE AND ORGANIZER OF THE COMPETITION

- 1.1. The competition will take place on the territory of "Baldones waterjump" on 19.08.2023
- 1.2. The competition program is drawn up by the Chief Judge, hereinafter - CJ,
- 1.3. Information about the specific competition program is available on the LSF website www.infoski.lv no later than 2 weeks before the competition.
- 1.4. In case, on the day of the competition, the climatic conditions on the track or the surface of the track do not allow proper holding of the competition, then CJ has the right to cancel the competition on the day specified in the regulations and change the competition program.
- 1.5. CJ has the right to determine any other day and time when the canceled competition will take place, informing the participants of the competition time.

2. COMPETITION MANAGEMENT

- 2.1. The LSF appoints competition CJ and monitors his activities.
- 2.2. CJ determines the number of judges, appoints them, dismisses them and monitors their activities.

3. EXAMINATION OF PROTESTS

- 3.1. Protests about the judges' actions are submitted to the Secretariat within 15 minutes after the last participant has started. These protests are reviewed by the GT, together with other competition judges.
- 3.2. The question of satisfying the protest is decided by a simple majority of votes. This decision is final and non-appealable.
- 3.3. The person submitting the protest together with the protest pays 30 euros (for each protest), which is received by the GT of the competition. In the event that the protest is justified and is satisfied, 30 euros must be returned to the protester.
- 3.4. In case the protest is not justified - 30 euros are credited to the organizer's current account.

4. PARTICIPANTS

- 4.1. Participants compete in two sports (freestyle skiing and freestyle snowboarding) and are divided into the following groups:

In the "Jib park jam" competition

- Youth born in 2009 and younger
- Open born in 2008 and older
- Girls (born in 2016 and older)

"Water jump best trick" competition

- Open (born in 2008 and older)

*If the participant is younger than born in 2016, but his physical, technical and mental preparation level corresponds to participation in the competition, GT has the right to allow the participant to participate in the competition in the youngest group.

- 4.2. If less than 4 people have signed up in the youngest group, that group is added to the oldest group. The same is for the girl group.
- 4.3. Only those persons who have signed the athlete's declaration and paid the participation fee can participate in the competition.
- 4.4. The athlete's declaration of minor participants (up to 18 years of age) can be signed by parents, guardians, coach, club representative and/or official representative of the national federation, who confirm responsibility for the said athlete with their signature.
- 4.5. CJ has the right to limit the number of participants in the competition if it creates conditions that endanger the health of the athletes.

5. "JIB PARK JAM" COMPETITION FORMAT, EVALUATION AND RATINGS

- 5.1. The competition takes place in the "jib jam" format. Park is built on a small hill, on which various elements of different complexity are created, on which tricks are performed.
- 5.2. Participants are divided into several groups or hits. Each group is given 15-20 minutes so that the riders can perform tricks.
- 5.3. The competition is evaluated by the participants themselves. Giving points immediately after the end of the competition. 1st place 100 points 2nd place 70 points 3rd place 50 points. Competition secretariat calculates all submitted results and determines the best 3 participants in each group.
- 5.4. Before the start of the competition, "riders meeting" takes place, where the course of the competition and the evaluation criteria are explained to the participants again.

6. WATERJUMP BEST TRICK COMPETITION PROCEDURE, EVALUATION AND RATINGS

- 6.1. The competition will have the "best trick" format. park is built on a small hill, on which you run with a springboard and land in the water.
- 6.2. Participants are given 5 chances to perform the 2 best tricks.
- 6.3. The competition is evaluated by the participants themselves. Giving your assessment immediately after the end of the competition. 1st place 100 points 2nd place 70 points 3rd place 50 points. In the overall ranking, the competition secretariat calculates all submitted results and determines 1 best driver in each group.
- 6.4. Before the start of the competition, a runners' meeting takes place, where the course of the competition and the evaluation criteria are explained to the participants again.

7. CONTEST ENTRY AND PARTICIPATION FEE

- 7.1. The application can be filled out at this link <https://forms.gle/wNBNopoCywgnKJjc9> no later than 12 hours before the competition, or must be submitted to the competition secretariat on the day of the competition at the time specified in the program.
- 7.2. The application is submitted by the athlete, the athlete's parents, the club or the responsible person of the club who represents the specific athlete.
- 7.3. Upon receipt of the application, the person designated by the club becomes a participant of the competition.
- 7.4. Upon arrival at the competition, the registered participant or the responsible person of the club represented by him must register with the CJ of the competition or the person designated by him in accordance with the procedure specified in the competition program.
- 7.5. If the participant is not registered by the end of the registration period set by CJ, then he will not be allowed to start.
- 7.6. If the participant has applied and registered, but has not started in the specific competition, then the responsible person of the club he represents returns everything that was assigned to the participants in the specific competition (start number, lift

card/s, ticket/s, etc.), otherwise LSF has the right to invoice the club for the damages caused in double amount.

- 7.7. Participants who, due to some circumstances, have missed their start, are allowed to start after the last participant in his group.
- 7.8. Competition participation is 20 euros, it can be paid here; <https://ticketshop.lv/lv/events/5286>
- 7.9. The competition entry fee is included in the entrance ticket to "JIBB JABB GAMES"

8. SAFETY

- 8.1. Each participant is responsible for his own safety during the competition and by signing the participant's declaration with his signature, he confirms that he is aware of the risk and took responsibility for his own safety. - 8.2. Participants must wear a helmet during the competition. Protective equipment for the back and knees is also recommended.
- 8.3. The organizers of the competition advise the participants to purchase health and life insurance for the duration of the competition.

9. AWARDING

- 9.1. The "Jib park jam" competition, the best 3 participants of each group will be awarded. In the "Waterjump best trick" competition, one best freestyle skier and one best snowboarder will be awarded.

10. ADVERTISING

- 10.1. Exclusive advertising placement rights during the competition belong to the organizers of the event.
- 10.2. All possible advertising placement during this time must be coordinated with the event organizers.

11. EFFECTIVENESS OF BYLAW AND ITS AMENDMENT.

- 11.1. This Regulation is valid until the next amendments.
- 11.2. The LSF board has the right to amend the regulations.
