



„MILZKALNS PARK BATTLE 2021” IN FREESTYLE SKIING AND SNOWBOARDING

1. COMPETITION DATE AND PLACE

- 1.1. 13th of march 2021
- 1.2. Competition will be held at recreation complex „Milzkalns”, "Dižkalni", Smārde Parish, Engure District, Latvia.

2. COMPETITION MANAGMENT

- 2.1. The organizer of the competition is "Latvian Ski Federation" in the following text LSF.
- 2.2. The LSF appoints the race chief judge in the following text CJ and monitors his activities.
- 2.3. The CJ determines the number of judges, appoints them, removes them from office and monitors their activities.

3. COMPETITION PROGRAM

- 3.1. The competition program is compiled by the CJ, with the prior agreement of the LFS.
- 3.2. Information about the specific competition program is available on the LSF website www.infoski.lv not later than 1 week before the competition.
- 3.3. In case the climatic conditions on the track or track surface on the day of the competition do not allow organizing the competition properly, then CJ has the right to cancel the competition on the day specified in the regulations and change the competition program.
- 3.4. CJ has the right to determine any other day and time when the canceled competition will take place, informing the participants of the competition in due time.
- 3.5. The competition is based on the FIS International Competition Rules.

4. REGISTRATION AND ENTREY FEE

- 4.1. The application for participation in the competition must be submitted to the LFS online registration program no later than 12 hours before the competition.
- 4.2. The application shall be submitted by the athlete, club or responsible person of the club representing the particular athlete.
- 4.3. The application must be submitted electronically when registering, the registration link will be indicated on the LFS website www.ski.lv.
- 4.4. Upon receipt of the application, the person indicated by the club becomes a participant in the competition.
- 4.5. The application may not be accepted if the person does not comply with Article 4 of these Regulations.
- 4.6. Upon arrival at the competition, the registered participant or the person in charge of the club he / she represents must register with the competition GT or his / her designated person and pay the participation fee in accordance with the procedure specified in the competition program.
- 4.7. If a participant is not registered by the end of the registration period specified by GT, then it will not be allowed at the start.

- 4.8. If a participant has applied and registered but has not started in the specific competition, then the responsible person of the club he / she represents returns everything that was assigned to the participants in the specific competition (start number, lift card / s, ticket / s, etc.), otherwise LSF has the right to invoice the club for the damage incurred in double amount.
- 4.9. Competitors who have missed their start due to any reason are admitted to the start after the last competitor in his group.
- 4.10. The competition participation fee is indicated in the competition program no later than one week before the date of the competition.
- 4.11. The organizers of the competition are entitled to grant a discount on the participation fee.

5. PARTICIPANTS

Participants compete in two different sports; freestyle skiing and snowboarding and are divided into the following groups:

Freestyle skiing

Snowboarding

Open	Born and older in 2006

- 5.1. Participants born between 2004 and 2006 are included in both the junior group and the open group.
- 5.2. Only those persons who have signed the athlete's declaration and paid the participation fee can participate in the competition.
- 5.3. The Athlete Declaration of Minor Participants (under the age of 18) may be signed by the parents, guardians, coach, club representative and / or official representative of the National Federation, who shall certify responsibility for the Athlete with their signature.
- 5.4. The GT is entitled to limit the number of competitors if it creates conditions that endanger the health of athletes.

6. COMPETITION FORMAT.

- 6.1. Participants are divided into several start groups, the number of which depends on the total number of participants in the competition.
- 6.2. The participant has the opportunity to make 3 runs, the participants of each start group make all runs in a row.
- 6.3. For the participants of the open group, the first 3 runs are like in the qualification competition, after which the participants who have shown the best 8 results qualify for the final competition.
- 6.4. In case there are 7 or less participants in the group, then the final competition does not take place and the points are evaluated according to the qualification competition.

7. EVALUATION AND RATINGS

- 7.1. The competition is judged by 2 - 5 judges. Each trip is rated on a 50-point scale. The rider gets the total result from the total of the two best ride points.
- 7.2. Judging is based on the principle of "overall impression". The overall impression is determined by the complexity of the tricks, the amplitude of the jump, the technique or style of execution, the accuracy of the landing, the uniqueness of the tricks and the choice of lines or trajectory and combination of elements.
- 7.3. Before the start of the competition there is a riders meeting, where the participants are again explained the course of the race and the evaluation criteria.

8. START BIB USAGE

- 8.1. The participant may be in the competition area only in a correctly put-up bib.
- 8.2. A competitor may be disqualified if during the track inspection, warm-up and competition, the start bib is worn incorrectly or is not worn.
- 8.3. After participating in the competition, the participant is obliged to return the bib to the competition secretariat.
- 8.4. In case of loss, intentional damage or non-return of the bib, the participant must cover the loss in the amount of 50 euros.

9. EXAMINATION OF PROTESTS

- 9.1. Protests against the actions of the judges shall be submitted to the Secretariat within 15 minutes after the last participant has started. These protests will be considered by CJ, together with the other judges.
- 9.2. The question of upholding the protest shall be decided by a simple majority. This decision is final and cannot be appealed.
- 9.3. The protester together with the protest pays 30 euros (for each protest), which is received by the CJ of the competition.
- 9.4. In case the protest is justified and satisfied, 30 euros must be returned to the protester.
- 9.5. In case the protest is not justified - 30 euros are transferred to the organizer's current account.

10. SAFETY

- 10.1. Each participant is responsible for his/her own safety during the competition and by signing the participant's declaration with his/her signature confirms that he/she is aware of the risk and took responsibility for his/her safety.
- 10.2. Competitors must wear a helmet during the competition. Protective equipment for the back and knees is also desirable.
- 10.3. The organizers of the competition recommend participants to buy health and life insurance for the duration of the competition.

11. AWARDING

- 11.1. The three best athletes of each group are awarded in the competition.
- 11.2. In the youth, junior and women's group, participants are awarded with diplomas, cups and prizes provided by supporters.
- 11.3. In the open group, the best three participants are awarded with diplomas, cups and cash prizes.
- 11.4. Participants with different nominations can be awarded separately.

12. ADVERTISEMENT

- 12.1. Exclusive advertising rights during the competition belong to the Organizers.

12.2. All possible advertising during this time must be agreed with the Organizers.

13. VALIDITY OF THE REGULATIONS AND ITS AMENDMENT

13.1. This Regulation is valid until the next amendments.

13.2. The LSF Board has the right to amend the Regulations.
