





FIS Points (Overall World Cup points + each stage according to FIS Rol

WC & WSC Rules 5.3.1.2). Extracts:

FIS ROL WC stage event points will be awarded after the last Stage In addition to the Overall World Cup points awarded, each stage will also according to the final FIS ROL WC stage standings. The factor will be 2, receive the following World Cup points. The daily World Cup points will i.e. the winner will receive 200 points:

Bonus seconds (according to FIS Rol WC & WSC Rules 5.3.1). Extract:

The overall results for the FIS ROL WC will be based on the overall time score in the all stages (including sprint).

There will be bonus seconds for the top 30 in the Sprint race. The bonus seconds listed below are subtracted from the competitor's actual race time before being added into the overall time score.

1st place = 30 seconds
2<sup>nd</sup> place = 27 seconds
3rd place = 24 seconds
4th place - 22 seconds
```









2. Sprint race – qualification

Position at start according to ICR 315.2.3

The competitor must have his feet behind the start line and remain stationary before the starter gives starting commands. The poles remain stationary and must be placed in front of the starting line and/or starting gate.





2. Sprint race - finals

Heat start procedure extract:

Competitors are organised on the pre-start line where instructions are given and start lanes designated. The starter will give the command "take your start positions" and the competitors advance to the start line. When all competitors are at the start line, the starter will give the command "Set" and all the competitors must remain motionless until the starter gives the start signal.

Jury directive: in order to facilitate the motionless phase, when the starter will give the command "Set" both rollerskis and poles must be steady on the ground until the start signal








2. Sprint race - finals


Jury directive: first 10 meters after start (start zone) skating won't be allowed.
